Rinderpest

Rinderpest is a plague in cattle that begins with a fever, weepy eyes, and a drippy muzzle. Dysentery and diarrhea follow and then death by dehydration. Rinderpest arrived alongside the domestication of cattle, in the Indus River Valley over 5000 years ago. It traveled west out of Asia with the Huns and Mongols. With the growth of the railroad Rinderpest spread so quickly that Europe was nearly cow free in 1870's. This summer, the Food and Agriculture Organization for the United Nations plans to formally announce Rinderpest's eradication, making it the second scourge after smallpox to be intentionally wiped off the face of the earth.
